Dear Senator Costa:

In the next few months, the CALFED Bay-Delta Program will be releasing its recommendations for a comprehensive solution to the critical water supply and environmental problems facing the Delta and the San Francisco Bay. The Bay-Delta Advisory Council (BDAC), whose members are charged with providing public policy advice to the Program, would benefit from an understanding of legislative concerns and interest as we move forward with a comprehensive program in the coming year.

BDAC will be holding its next meeting in Sacramento on November 4th and 5th. I am writing to invite you to participate in an informal evening program on November 4th with Assemblymember Mike Machado (invited), and BDAC members to discuss the issues you think will be foremost, from the legislators point of view, in selecting and supporting a long-term Bay-Delta solution.
