
Enclosed is information regarding the process used to evaluate and select directed programs under the Restoration Coordination Program (Attachment A). As you know, CALFED recently approved 13 directed programs. Those were presented to the Ecosystem Roundtable at the February 3, 1999 meeting (Attachment B). Also included is a copy of each of those proposals.

Previously approved directed programs are listed in Attachment C. Those projects were reviewed by the Ecosystem Roundtable and CALFED Policy Group prior to approval. The Scope of Work for each of these directed programs is enclosed for your information. Full proposals were not required at the time these programs were approved.

The project selection process continues to evolve and become more specific as CALFED identifies Stage 1 implementation actions. We strive to use early implementation funds in areas which will provide us the greatest ecological benefit and take us the furthest in meeting CALFED goals.
