Subject: 1999 CALFED Proposals Recommended For Funding

On June 1 - 4, 1999, the Integration Panel convened to discuss the 226 proposals that were received during the 1999 Proposal Solicitation Process. On June 7, 1999, the Integration Panel recommended 34 proposals to the Ecosystem Roundtable for funding. The Ecosystem Roundtable met on June 16, 1999, and recommended 16 proposals for funding without conditions. The Ecosystem Roundtable met again on July 6, 1999, and after further discussion, recommended funding the remaining 17 proposals with conditions. One proposal, 99-B131 Yuba Tools, was not recommended for funding and will be considered by the CALFED Policy Group at their August 12, 1999 meeting. CALFED Policy Group met on June 17, 1999, and the Bay-Delta Advisory Council met on July 9, 1999, and both groups concurred with the Ecosystem Roundtable's recommendation to fund 33 proposals for a total of \$18,343,947.

Of the 33 proposals, 12 proposals for a total of \$7,053,246, have been identified and recommended for funding through Proposition 204 funds. A letter for your signature approving these 12 proposals is attached.

In addition, we have attached an overall status of the Proposition 204 funds, and projects approved to date.
