

Re: Request from Senator Costa Regarding Expenditures on Water Storage Facility Studies

This memo is a request for assistance in responding to an inquiry from Senator Costa regarding expenditures for studies for water storage facilities.

During an August 26, 1999 meeting of the Senate Select Committee on the CALFED Water Program, Senator Jim Costa asked Steve Ritchie for a short report and discussion of expenditures from past appropriations for water supply storage facility studies. Senator Costa asked for an explanation of the connections between DWR's investigations of Sites reservoir location and CALFED's Integrated Storage Investigation. He also asked for a short report on how past appropriations to DWR and CALFED for storage studies have been spent, how much more funding will be needed, and when we expect to reach a conclusion on the need for additional storage.

We propose to consult with DWR staff working on the Sites reservoir studies and prepare a draft response for your concurrence.
