

RESOLUTION No. 021-2000
OF THE EL DORADO COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
 IN SUPPORT OF A CALFED BAY-DELTA PROGRAM WHICH PROVIDES A
 WATER SUPPLY AND WATER QUALITY SOLUTION NEEDS FOR
 ALL BENEFICIAL USES OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

WHEREAS, the El Dorado County Board of Supervisors is a political subdivision of the State of California with statutory water resources responsibilities; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors is located within the CALFED BAY-DELTA PROGRAM'S Solution Area; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors is supportive of a CALFED Program that does not result in significant redirected environmental, or socio/economic impacts within the State; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors supports the premise that water supply reliability, affordability and quality are of paramount importance in any final CALFED BAY-DELTA PROGRAM solution; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors has historically supported the application of, and defense of, the County of Origin, Watershed of Origin, and similar statutes, as part of any water allocation, appropriation, or other such assignment; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors recognizes that the restoration of the Ecosystem of the Bay-Delta is an issue of statewide concern; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors supports an open public process with ample opportunity for meaningful participation by members of the general public, interest groups and local elected officials; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors believes that the CALFED BAY-DELTA PROGRAM does not currently comply with these objectives; and

WHEREAS, the County seeks to work towards a balanced, sustainable, achievable and affordable CALFED BAY-DELTA PROGRAM solution.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the El Dorado County Board of Supervisors, that the attached ACTION PRINCIPLES for the CALFED BAY-DELTA PROGRAM represent issues which we believe must be addressed in a timely manner for the CALFED BAY-DELTA PROGRAM to maintain a reasonable chance of success in achieving its objectives; and


