Dear Governor Davis:

As the leader of our state, you have the opportunity to steer California away from environmentally destructive, highly polluting, and wasteful water usage practices. We can have clean, healthy rivers that support fish and wildlife and sufficient water for families, farms and businesses.

I urge you to ensure the CALFED Bay/Delta program:

1. Invests in water efficiency for at least seven years before even considering new dams or reservoirs.
2. Restores rivers, bays and fisheries by providing adequate fresh water and caring for the land around the rivers.
3. Enforces pollution limits to improve water quality for people and wildlife.
4. Puts a stop to having taxpayers pay for studies of new dams and reservoirs that flood needed wildlife habitat and remove needed water from our rivers.

We now have the opportunity to choose a smarter course that will improve water quality, protect our watersheds and fisheries, and invest in water conservation to make our communities self-reliant. Please assure that we achieve these objectives.





