CALFED PREFERRED ALTERNATIVE

I have enclosed for your information a motion regarding the CALFED Bay-Delta process that was approved by the Los Angeles County Board of Supervisors on August 18, 1998. This motion recognizes the importance of restoring the environmental and ecological values of the Delta. It also supports the notion that increased demand management and recycling must be a part of the County's total water picture. In areas of demand management and recycling, Los Angeles County and Southern California lead the State. By this motion, the Board has endorsed Alternative Three. In a County which imports approximately two-thirds of its water supply, the Board is very concerned about the reliability and quality of those supplies. Alternative Three is clearly the superior choice as demonstrated by your own studies.
