**SUBJECT: RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF CALFED BAY-DELTA ECOSYSTEM PROJECT**

**RECOMMENDATION:** Adopt Resolution 98-212 supporting the CALFED six common program elements; and participate in meaningful measures to implement reasonable and cost-effective demand management strategies; and support expansion of the use of recycled waters to the extent of our authority; and strongly endorse the CALFED Preferred Alternative Three, which will provide a reliable, high quality water supply to Southern California and at the same time provide for a comprehensive solution to the ecosystem of the Bay Delta.

**BACKGROUND:** The CALFED partnership of state and federal agencies along with urban, agricultural, and environmental interests have been working together since 1994 to develop a long-term solution to the Bay-Delta ecosystem problem.

The Bay-Delta provides a significant portion of the imported water supply to Southern California. Our region's increasing population, coupled with the continuing growth of our diverse economy, require that Southern California remain heavily dependent on this region for a portion of our water supply.
