As you are aware CALFED is counting on significant actions to take place within the Solution area to solve the problems of the Delta estuary. These actions within the solution area are themselves comprehensively predicated upon compliance with the CALFED solution principals.

The City of Redding, located along the Sacramento River, has identified a number of issues of importance to their citizens which are similar in many ways to many more "citizens of the solution area".

Therefore, when you read the attached information regarding the City of Redding's Goals for the CALFED Program, I hope that you will do so in recognition that these themes are common to many in the solution area.


The list contains not only a summary of issues which potentially may adversely affect the City, but also a list of proposed ecosystem restoration actions which could significantly benefit the Bay-Delta system through early implementation. The paper contains proposals for ecosystem and water quality actions which could be replicated in many areas with similar

positive results for downstream areas. This is demonstrative of actions which can be taken by urban areas, tributary to the Delta, to provide real benefits to the CALFED Program.
