Dear Citizen:

On behalf of the CALFED Bay-Delta Program, I would like to express our thanks for your communication, either by letter or by telephone, urging the removal of four dams in the Central Valley for their potential contribution toward improving river ecosystem health.

CALFED, its participating agencies, and local watershed groups here in the Sacramento Valley already have made great strides toward the actions that you have mentioned. Clough Dam on Mill Creek was destroyed in last winter's devastating floods and CALFED is working with the local diverters to ensure it will not be rebuilt. Negotiations are well underway that, if successful, will lead to the opportunity to remove Eagle Canyon Dam on Battle Creek. Currently CALFED is working with local interests to determine how to proceed with evaluations of restoration options at the Centerville Head Dam on Butte Creek and at Englebright Dam on the Yuba River.

Thank you again for sharing your views with us.
