Dear Mr. Ritchie:

I attended the workshop that was held in Visalia and want to thank you for the informative presentation. Our Board of Directors reviewed the information at our regular meeting on the 21<sup>st</sup> of February and they concur with KCWA/BVCSD that "first tier" wholesale water suppliers not be held responsible for compliance of their retail customers. If there is no responsibility by "first tier" wholesale water suppliers for their retail customers then there should be no need for anyone other than the water provider that fails to receive certification to be able to appeal CUWCC's decision.

Decision making should be made by a nine-member certification committee as described in KCWA/BVCSD's second proposal. The other areas where two trains of thought were recorded were generally more straight forward in KCWA/BVCSD's proposals.
