

Subject : Review of the CALFED Draft Environmental Impact Statement/Report (DEIS/R) and
Technical Appendices

CALFED has sent out their DEIS/R for public review. Several of you within the unit have received a complete set of the DEIS/R and Technical Appendices, while others (the lucky ones) have received the Executive Summary and Phase II Interim Report. Mr. Ryan Brodrick stated that the review of the DEIS/R should not be considered an assignment, but rather as an opportunity to guide the selection of a preferred alternative. I agree with that statement. I also believe that the review of the DEIS/R will provide our unit with the knowledge necessary to facilitate the implementation of the Ecosystem Restoration Program Plan (ERPP) components and help us with the permit coordination effort assigned to our unit.
