**Background:**

The California Bay-Delta Authority is charged with oversight and coordination of the CALFED Bay-Delta Program, a cooperative effort among state and federal agencies and the public to ensure a healthy ecosystem, reliable water supplies, good quality, and stable levees in California's Bay-Delta system. The Water Use Efficiency (WUE) Program is one of several Program elements the Authority is coordinating through an integrated approach. The August 2000 CALFED Record of Decision called for the creation of a WUE Subcommittee to advise state and federal agencies on structure and implementation of assistance programs, and to coordinate federal, state, regional and local efforts for maximum effectiveness.

**Purpose of Meeting:**

The April 21, 2005, meeting will provide an opportunity to review and discuss: 1) the revised draft WUE Program Plan; 2) the status of Quantifiable Objectives implementation; and, 3) updates on several other WUE Program actions and related activities.
