REQUEST FOR QUALIFICATIONS SOLICITATION PACKAGE SYNOPSIS

The Delta Stewardship Council (Council) was established by S.B. No. 1 (Ch. 5, Stats. 09-10, 7th Ex. Sess.), which takes effect February 3, 2010. Pursuant to that legislation, the Council is required to develop, adopt, and commence implementation of a comprehensive resources management plan for the Delta, referred to as the Delta Plan, on or before January 1, 2012.

Contractor(s) will be asked to provide the following services and expertise to support the development of the Delta Plan:

1. Project management
2. Technical services
3. Environmental services, including preparation of State and Federal environmental review documents

The final product will be a completed draft Delta Plan and CEQA/NEPA compliance document.
